



NOTIFICATION TO WISCONSIN DAIRY PRODUCERS

If you are a dairy producer interested in running for a Wisconsin Milk Marketing Board director seat, the nomination period is open now through February 24, 2012.

Wisconsin's milk marketing order requires the election of one-third of the marketing board each year. Eight director positions representing the following districts are up for election in 2012: 2, 5, 8, 11, 14, 17, 20, 23 (refer to map on postcard front to view affected counties). Elections will take place April 9-28, 2012. Elected directors will serve a three-year term beginning July 1, 2012, through June 30, 2015. Only affected producers are eligible to nominate a director or be nominated. "Affected producer" is defined as an individual, partnership or other business entity in Wisconsin engaged in the production and sale of milk.

Election information and nomination forms are available through the Wisconsin Department of Agriculture, Trade and Consumer Protection (contact Noel Favia at 608-224-5140) or can be downloaded at www.wmmb.com/elections.

Once the requested form is received or downloaded, the nominee:

- must obtain five or more signatures from producers who reside in the nominee's district.
- is required to complete the "Affidavit of Eligibility" section of the nomination form, then sign the form in the presence of a Notary Public.

Return completed, notarized nomination forms to the department, postmarked no later than February 24, 2012.
